Dear Friends,

The four Sundays prior to Christmas mark the season of Advent for the church, a traditional time during which believers contemplate and prepare for the celebration of the Christmas season, which runs from Christmas Day through Epiphany, on January 6th. Advent has a collection of hymns all its very own, which are about the anticipation of Christ's birth. They differ from "Christmas hymns," which celebrate that birth.

I've been in a lot of churches in which Christmas hymns simply were not sung at all until the Christmas season. That may be liturgically proper, but I also think it's a bit of a Grinch-like rule for a church to follow. Nevertheless, it is important for us to incorporate some Advent hymns into the Advent season, and among the greatest of these is, "Come, Thou Long -Expected Jesus."



"Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus" was written by John Wesley's brilliant brother, Charles (1707-1788), who penned approximately 6,500 hymns. This beloved song speaks of our annual anticipation of the coming of Jesus into our world, he who was "born to set thy people free," and "born a child and yet a king." As one resource puts it, "This beloved Advent text by Charles Wesley touches the full range of biblical memory and human hope, evoking the promise of Christ's coming to transform human life in the present."

Published in 1744, "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus" is sung to the Welsh tune "Hyfrydol" (one of my favorite words!), which means "good cheer." The site Hymnary.org notes that the song has been published in at least 745 hymnals.

Advent gives us an opportunity to consider the miraculous blessing of Christ's entrance into our world. Hymns like "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus," passed down through the generations, help focus our worship on this beautiful gift from God.

Five women met in fellowship hall November 6, 2024. President Marci Welliever opened the meeting with prayer at 7 PM.


Secretary's Report: The minutes from the October 2, 2024, meeting were read and approved.
